What is a Farm Safety Walk & Talk?

An opportunity to discuss and improve your understanding of all things health and safety with your farming neighbours.

How many participants are needed?

Between eight and 14 is ideal but Farm Safety Walk & Talks have been conducted with as few as four or as many as 24.

What is the format for the Farm Safety Walk & Talk?

This is a presentation style format with time for questions and discussion on health & safety. We cover topics such as:

- Who has responsibilities?
- · What are those responsibilities?
- How do you meet those responsibilities?
- What records do you need to keep?
- What's new in health and safety?

We will then walk the farm to discuss specifics on potential hazards such as shearing sheds, chemical storage, plant and machinery, working at heights, working with livestock, loading ramps and yards, overhead fuel, farm workshop and silo safety etc.



How much time does it take?

Up to three hours depending on the group and the size of the farm.

What is needed?

A volunteered farm, a group of farmers, and something for morning or afternoon tea.
