What are my responsibilities?

You are responsible for everyone on your farm, including:

- Employees
- Casuals
- · Labour Hire
- Contractors
- Subcontractors
- Farm visitors
- · Family and Friends

Health and safety laws require the provision and maintenance of a working environment that is safe for everyone and without risks to health.

Why is this important?

Should someone be injured on your farm, you may need to provide documentation to show that you have provided a safe and healthy workplace. The best way to do this is to make sure you are familiar with the latest OH&S requirements and maintain up-to-date records.

How much time does it take?

Up to three hours depending on the size of the farm.

What does this service provide?

This service will help you set up the foundations of a simple process to manage health and safety on your farm.
