

Victorian Farmer Magazine Readership Survey 2022 Terms and Conditions

- 1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. All times are based on VIC local time.
- 2. Entry is only open to residents of Victoria aged 18 years or over.
- 3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or first cousin.
- 4. Entries into the promotion open at 5 pm on 26 July 2022 and close at 5 pm on 1 September 2022 (Promotional Period).
- 5. There will be an online survey for this promotion, in the winter edition of 'Victorian Farmer' and on vff.org.au
- 6. Each of the advertisements will contain a QR code and link. To be eligible to enter, individuals must fully complete the survey during the Promotional Period.
- 7. Only one (1) entry is permitted per person.
- 8. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age, VFF membership status and place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
- 9. Incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible entries will be deemed invalid.
- 10. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
- 11. There will be one (1) draw conducted for entries received. The draw will take place at Level 3, 24 Collins Street, Melbourne VIC 3000 at 10 am on 2 September 2022. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn. Winners will be notified in writing by email and winners must respond to the Promoter within 48 hours of winner notification in order to claim their prize.
- 12. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13. One valid entry drawn will win a \$500 Bunnings voucher redeemable at Bunnings.
- 14. Only one (1) prize is permitted per household.

Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury or loss or damage (including loss of opportunity), whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.
- 22. Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter



(including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury, loss or damage (including loss of opportunity), whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of any:

- technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control)
- theft, unauthorised access or third-party interference
- entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter

As a condition of accepting the prize, a winner must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter and/or prize suppliers in their absolute discretion, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form. 24. The Promoter collects personal information (PI) in order to conduct the promotion and may, for this purpose, disclose such PI to third parties, including but not limited to agents, contractors, service providers, prize suppliers and, as required, to Australian regulatory authorities. Entry is conditional on providing this PI. The Promoter will also use and handle PI as set out in its Privacy Policy. In addition to any use that may be outlined in the Promoter's Privacy Policy, the Promoter may, for an indefinite period, unless otherwise advised, use the PI for promotional, marketing, publicity, research and profiling purposes, including sending electronic messages or telephoning the entrant. The Privacy Policy also contains information about how entrants may opt out, access, update or correct their PI, how entrants may complain about a breach of the Australian Privacy Principles or any other applicable law and how those complaints will be dealt with. All entries become the property of the Promoter. The Promoter will not disclose PI to any entity outside of Australia.
